## Rehearsal Schedule and Participation

This year, we kick off our season with full-band rehearsals starting on Monday, August 3<sup>rd</sup>. The complete pre-camp and camp schedule has not changed since the Spring Meeting in April, but I'm including it in case you need a reminder. Our two weeks of evening "pre-camp" will be spent mostly in music rehearsal, with a small amount of time being dedicated to basic marching fundamentals in the second week. Even though many of you have already been exposed to our "high energy" marching style, we'll be starting again from the most basic of marching fundamentals in order to give our newest members every opportunity to become comfortable with our style. This will give all returning members a great opportunity to review and sharpen their marching skills as well.

## Information Forms and Calendar

Additional information including Emergency Medical Forms, Band Camp Prescription forms, and Maps to Band Camp for Visitor's night (Thursday only please) will be distributed during the week of August 3<sup>rd</sup> at our rehearsals. You will also receive a calendar that provides a tentative schedule for the entire 09-10 school year. I want to impress upon you how important it is to keep this calendar handy throughout the year. ## Financial Obligations

Included in this mailing is a financial statement. This statement contains updated credit balances for those who have flower sale or other credits, and will outline the details of your financial obligation for the year. This information is based on the intent form/uniform order sheet filled out in late May. Payment for band camp/uniform items is due before we leave for camp on Sunday, August 16<sup>th</sup>.

Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions regarding finances. Our new treasurer, Kathy Parrish, and I are more than willing to speak with you about any questions or concerns you may have. As was mentioned at the Spring Meeting, it is important to understand the financial obligations associated with participation in band. However, it is my belief that **financial matters should not keep a student from participating in our band program**. If you contact me with a concern along that line, **I can help**, provided that you and your student are willing to work to help yourself!

Good faith payment efforts during the summer are also greatly appreciated. You can mail a payment (even a few dollars here and there helps defer the cost) to the address at the top of the newsletter. Any donations or payments received over the summer will be applied to your total balance. It's a great way to get a head start on the August 16<sup>th</sup> payment.

## Drumline and Flag Camp

As many of you have seen on the calendar at [www.lancerband.net](http://www.lancerband.net), the Drumline and Flag sections will be holding sectional rehearsals during the weeks leading up to Pre-Camp. Drumline sectionals will be held Monday through Wednesday, July 20<sup>th</sup>-22<sup>nd</sup> (see online calendar for details), and Flag day-camp will be held Monday July 27<sup>th</sup>-Friday July 31<sup>st</sup> from 9-2. All rehearsals will be held in the band room.

## Uniforms

Uniform fittings will be taking place beginning the week of July 13<sup>th</sup> on Tuesday, Thursday and Friday evenings. You will be receiving a phone call to set up a fitting. Please wear athletic shorts and a t-shirt (no structured shorts or jeans) so we can accurately fit your uniform. Also, please plan on bringing your Summer Uniform Black Pants (See Uniform page of newsletter) so we can make sure they’re the right style and length.

## **PRECAMP AND BAND CAMP SCHEDULES**

**Week #1** (Monday - Friday August 3<sup>rd</sup>- August 7<sup>th</sup>) will consist of full band music rehearsals and some sectional rehearsals. These rehearsals will be held at LHS from 5-8pm.

**Week #2** (Monday – Thursday August 10<sup>th</sup>-13<sup>th</sup>) will include full band music rehearsals, sectional rehearsals, and basic marching fundamentals. These rehearsals will be held at LHS from 5-9pm. Bring dinner or a snack! We will not rehearse on Friday August 14<sup>th</sup>, in order for all members to better prepare for camp.

**Week #3 BAND CAMP!** (Sunday - Friday, August 16 - 21) This is my favorite week of the year! Band Camp will again be held at the Ohio Retreat Center in Marengo, OH. ALL MEMBERS ARE FULLY EXPECTED TO ATTEND. The cost of camp is \$160.00. If you have more than one child in band the cost for each additional child is \$140.00. Many students have already raised all or most of this amount through the Timbuk Flower Sale earlier this spring. All credit information has been compiled and a balance statement has been included in this mailing. I welcome your questions and/or concerns regarding camp. Beginning immediately, you may pay all or part of your fees at your earliest convenience.

**School Year Rehearsals:** Evening Rehearsals (6-8:30) will be held Monday and Wednesday evenings throughout the football season.

All of the above items (except the black pants, black socks, and black belts) are to be purchased through the Lakewood Band Boosters to insure uniformity. The black pants may be purchased anywhere. We are looking for casual-dress slacks (Dockers or equivalent), **not** work-style, bell bottoms, polyester, "carpenter" or "cargo" pants. There should be no pockets on the thighs or calves. Also, NO SKINNY BLACK PANTS ARE PERMITTED!

**Black Pant Advice:** BUY MEN'S PANTS! If you head to any department store, look for men's plain black pants. These will typically come with a pleated front and in the "Docker's" style. The best part about men's pants is that you can buy them with the appropriate waist and length measurements! That way, you can avoid looking sloppy or having to hem the pants!
